1. Along with the Bible Stories we have our toddlers set, the MBF.

3. She won the Edison award for excellence in the character development of younger children.
4. The stories are written with rhyme, rhythm, and repetition. BENEFIT
5. You can see that the pages are 85% picture and just 15% words. BENEFIT
6. Read Baby Jesus.
7. The stories also bring out the character developing morals. For example when Joseph was sold as a slave into Egypt it says...Read
8. They also bring out the spiritual lessons as well. We read that...Read
9. When I read this story, I'm reminded that Joseph was just a young boy when he was sold into slavery, but he still remembered the lessons his father had taught him when he was young.
10. Ten trillion bits close. (By the time they're six years old, it takes a lifetime to learn that much more information)
11. This shows us the importance of training our children properly at an early age.

Extra info for use in some canvasses:

- Pages are extra thick. Tear resistant, and little fingers can turn them better.
- Lots of stories about babies because babies like to hear about other babies.
- Models actually posed for these pictures to make them more life-like.
- The set is designed to fit different levels of children's attention. (The first sentence on each page can be read for children with short attention spans and it will correspond with the picture on that page.)
